seal this 14th day of November 1837.

This last Will and Testament of Goodman Johnson said was proved by the affirmations of Edwin Milford and Robert
son & Milford, two of the Ministers here, and sworn to be recorded. And on the motion of Josiah Holliman the executor therein
named who made oath and together with Edwin Milford and Augustus Ballard his securities entered into and acknowledged
a bond in the penalty of one thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs, to be granted him for obtaining a probate
of said Will in due form.
