Miggins all of my house hold and kitchen furniture to be equally divided between both of them, to their heirs and assigns forever. I also bequeath unto my daughter Martha one silver watch to him his heirs and assigns forever. I do constitute John E. Peck and Redick Darden Executors to this my last will and testament. I M. Drake whose I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 23th of September 1837
