In the name of God amen I Simon Westbrooks of this County of Southampton and State of Virginia, Master of the 28th day of May, 1825, being in perfect health and of sound mind do make and ordain, this my last Will and Testament as followeth: Viz. Item 1st. My wish and desire is that all my just and honorable debts and funeral expenses be paid first by my representatives, who I shall hereafter appoint.

I And I leave to my brother Simon T. Westbrooks all my estate both real and personal during his natural life; and if he the sd. S. T. Westbrooks should marry and have lawful issue, I, in that event give and bequeath an to him the said Simon Turner Westbrooks all my Estate before named.

I And I should my brother Simon T. Westbrooks die without marrying and having the lawful issue before named, it is my wish and desire that my Estate both real and personal be equally divided, between the surviving children of my mother John Westbrooks and Joel Westbrooks. And In the event that none of those children be surviving, it is my wish that all my Estate both real and personal shall be sold by my representatives, and paid over to the Treasurer of the Orphans, Widow's Son Lodge No 150 of in existence for the benefit of said Lodge.
