few goods which he has given me do make and ordain this my last will and testament in manner and for
following M'DCXXXI Simpson's - After the payment of all my just debts and funeral expenses - it
is my will and desire that if my beloved son Benjamin H. Hancock shall attain to the age of twenty
one, that he shall be the whole and sole heir of all my estate.

I also But in case my beloved son Benjamin H. Hancock shall not attain to the age above mentioned,
it is my will and desire then that my estate shall be equally divided between the lawful heirs of the
of my beloved brother James Washington.

Lastly I nominate constituents and appoint Thomas J. Drumwright my whole and sole Executor but
revoking all other wills by me, at any time herebefore made by me. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and affixed my seal this 14th day of August 1837.
