Drumwright, the executor therein named, appearing in Court and refusing to take upon himself the burthen of the execution of the said Will on the motion of Benjamin M. Hancock, who made oath and together with Lewis St. Bourne and Alfred J. Boulden, his securities, entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Three Thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs, Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of the said Henry Hancock decd with his said will annexed in due form.
