

remained part of my estate both real and personal, and out of the proceeds of the same I pay all my just debts and expenses and out of what may then remain I wish him to pay to my wife Patsy the sum of twenty five dollars annually until the whole of my estate is disposed of, upon the condition that she remain my widow long enough to consume the whole, but should she marry or die the whole of my estate is used in the manner as above described, whatever may then remain I give and bequeath to William Henry Griffin son of Benjamin Griffin to him and his heirs forever.

Lastly I do hereby nominate and appoint my brother Benja Griffin as my whole and sole executor to this my last will and testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 20th day of May 1837.
