mains my widow long enough to consume the whole, but should she marry or die the whole of my estate
is to be in the manner as above described, whatever may then remain I give and bequeath to Will
iam Henry Griffin son of Benjamin Griffin to him and his heirs forever.

Lastly I do hereby nominate and appoint my brother Benj'n Griffin as my sole and sole Executor
of this my last will and testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 20th
day of May 1837.
