In stating the transactions of James Myrick Curator of Joseph Harris, it will appear that in the 1830 there is an item paid N. Parsons of \$4.50 twice changed to the estate; and in the same year, Sep 22d the Curator has credit for \$3.00 paid J. Corfey, Guardian &c when it should be \$3.00 - so by deducting the first named item from the latter it will appear that the Curator should have a further credit of \$22.67 with interest thereon from the 31st day of Dec. 1830 to the 26th of May 1836 to wit,
