In the name of God Amen I Martha Channell be of a sound mind and disposing memory do hereby make this my last will and Testament in manner whereof witnesseth (I) I give unto my Daughter Lucy Atkins Ten dollars I also leave to the said Lucy one Feather bed and furniture best choice and one large Blue chest during her lifetime and then my share in the said bed and furniture and chest shall be divided between my sons James Channell and Nathaniel Channell (I) I give unto my son Nathaniel Channell Ten dollars (I) I give unto my son James Channell Ten dollars (I) I give unto my grand Daughter Martha Channell one wearing gown and (I) I give unto my grand son Elbert Channell one Feather bed and furniture last chair also my plantation whereon I live and my share is if the said Elbert Channell should age before he should arrive to the age of Twenty one years that the said plantation shall be sold and the proceeds of the same be equally divided between my grand children (I) I give unto my grand daughter Joseph Channell Henry Channell and Bennett Channell and Lucy Atkins my Daughter and all the balance of my estate to be sold and after my Just debts are paid out of the proceeds the remainder to be Equally divided between the above named children (I) I give unto my grand daughter Joseph Channell Henry Channell Bennett Channell and Lucy Atkins and Elbert Channell I leave Henry Hundred my Executor to this my last will and Testament witness my hand and seal this Twelfth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Twenty Eight
