 first choice and one large blue chest during her lifetime and then my said bed and furniture
 and chest shall be divided between my sons James Channell and Nathaniel Channell (\$10. Item) I
 give unto my son Nathaniel Channell Ten dollars (\$10. Item) I give unto my son James Channell
 Ten dollars (\$Item) I give unto my grand Daughter Martha Channell one weaning boar and four
 Item) I give unto my grand son Elbert Channell one feather bed and furniture last choice
 also my plantation whereon I live and my said Elbert Channell should age before
 he should arrive to the age of Twenty one years that the said plantation shall be sold and the
 proceeds of the same be equally divided between my Grand children (viz) Martha Channell with
 Channell Henry Channell Bennett Channell and Lucy Channell my Daughter and all
 the balance of my estate to be sold and after my just debts are paid out of the proceeds the
 remainder to be Equally divided between the above named children (viz) Martha Channell
 Joseph Channell Henry Channell Bennett Channell and Lucy Channell and Elbert
 Channell I leave Henry Hinder my Executor to this my last will and Testament
 witness my hand and seal this Twelfth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand
 eight hundred and Twenty Eight
