James M Parkers debt with the will annexed of Temperance Parkers dec.

At a Court held for the County of Southampton on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of October 1838

The Inventory and appraisement of the Estate of Temperance Parkers dec<sup>d</sup> was returned and ordered to be recorded

In the name of god doover I Rebecca Simmons of the County of Southampton & State of Virginia being of sound mind and memory, do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following to wit, Viz,

Item 1<sup>st</sup>. I give and bequeath to my Daughter Louisa including one feather bed & furniture & also all amounts of money that she may owe me at my death of whatever kind or account to her and her heirs forever.

Item 2<sup>d</sup>. I leave to my Daughter Emma Dinning during her natural life or until she may have a child one feather bed & furniture which she now has in possession, in case she has a child, I give the said bed & furniture to that one and its heirs forever. But in case she has no child I give and bequeath the said bed & furniture to be equal divided between my Daughters Louisa Darling & Mary Applewhite to them and their heirs forever.

Item 3<sup>d</sup>. I give and bequeath to my Daughter Mary Applewhite one bed & furniture & one cow which she now has in possession & her increase; one cedar chest & also all amounts of money which she may owe me at my death, which to me as Executor of Estate Simmons or debt contracted to me individually to her and her heirs forever.

Item 4<sup>th</sup>. After paying my just debts I give the balance of my Estate of money to Benjamin Applewhite to him and his heirs forever.

Item 5<sup>th</sup>. And lastly I do constitute & appoint Benjamin Applewhite my sole Executor to this my last will and Testament—Solely having all other will heretofore made by me. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affix my seal this Twenty-ninth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & thirty seven
