And on the motion of Clement Rockelle the Executor herein named who made oath and together with James Mayet his security in due unto and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Two Thousand dollars Conditioned as the said devisor Certificate is granted him for retaining a basket of the said will and seal formed.
