The said wife and Jurors of Stephen Whitehead did was proved by the oath of Benjamin Rochelle Samuel Dechenard and Patrick Griffin the subscribing Witnesses Thence and ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of Clement Rochelle the Executrix therein named who on oath and together with James Magot his security entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of two thousand dollars conditions as the said decessit Contract is granted herein found retaining a bond of the said Will in due form
