3^d I do hereby appoint and ordain this my last will and Testament disseminating at the time

of October AD 1834.

all Jonathan Jenkins my body but of a sound mind and memory do think proper to make this writing as and for my last will

and Diza Doyal forty six dollars in money I also give them my smallest bed and furniture no
Item. I give and bequeath to my sister Polly Jenkins my largest bed and furniture two Cots and
Culver two Tables four chairs two pots one Spidew one spinning wheel one chest and all other items of
my property consisting of what it may. It is my will and desire that one half of my lawful debt if any
should be paid off by my Executor out of the amount of property given by me to the Doyal children and
the other half out of the property given by me to my sister Polly Jenkins.
Lastly I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint James S Williams as my whole and sole Executor to
this my last will and Testament revoking all other wills heretofore made by me. In Testimony whereof
