

At a Court held for the County of Southampton on the 21st day of October 1839
 The writing bearing date September 23 1835 purporting to be the last will and Testament
 of Stephen Mordaugh sr was produced in Court and there being no subscribing Witnesses there
 William L Parker Joseph J Blaud William J Schell and Robert Richs were sworn, who severally
 deposted and said that they are acquainted with the hand writing of the said Stephen
 Mordaugh and that they verily believe the body of the said writing as well as the signature
 there to be in the hand writing of the said Stephen Mordaugh, Whereupon it is ordered
 that the said writing be Received as & for the last will and Testament of the said Stephen
 Mordaugh sr. And on the Motion of James D Mufsonburg the executor therein named
 who made Oath and together with Robert Richs Allen Edwards and William Briggs his
 securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Ten thousand dollars
 Conditioned as the Law directs Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probat thereof
 in due form. Libty being reserved for the executor therein named to be joined in the said
 probat when she thinks fit.
