In the name of God Amen. I Easter Joyner of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia being at this time in health both of body and mind do make this to be my last will and Testament in form following

1st Item I do give to Mathew R. Pope one white Contingy pin and also one bed and furniture to be divided equally between Mathew R. Pope and Matthew Joyner

2nd Also I do give to Elizabeth Williams one dressing Table and also five dollars and also one large corner

3rd And also I do give to Rebecca Hooks one Trunk

4th And also I do give to Elizabeth Dacula Turner one Trunk and now last of all I do give the balance of my estate to my loving Sister Catherine Joyner In Witness whereof I hereto set my hand and seal this 21st day of January 1820
