Lastly, I constitute and appoint my much esteemed friend Peter Edwards executor to this my last will and Testament revoking all others heretofore by me made. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this Twenty sixth day of March One thousand eight hundred and forty six.

Parsons his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Ten thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the said decedent's estate with her Will aforesaid annexed in due form.
