Rogers, Tammis Barnes, James Sherrard and Ethelred of Peebles being duly sworn deposed and say that they verily believe the said paper writing and every part thereof to be in the proper hand writing of the said Nicholas Edmunds and it appearing to the Court that the said paper writing was deposited in the hands of Howell Edmunds by the Testator for safe keeping. Thereupon it is ordered & adjudged by the Court that the said paper writing purporting to be the last will and Testament of Nicholas Edmunds doth in due proportion be recorded and it appearing to the Court that the executors therein named is not a resident of this state it is ordered that he enter into bond and security whereupon Howell Edmunds the executors therein named in said will entered into bond in the penalty of fifteen thousand dollars conditioned &c with Tammis Barnes and Ethelred of Peebles securities and qualified as the law directs
