

The balance found and the administrator in 1835 being very small refunded to him as the accounts show I have allowed no interest thereon - The administrator exhibited the following claims in favor of the estate which he states he has been unable to collect to wit a judgment against John Robinson vs John Washed for \$6.52 with int. from 30 Nov 1831 - a note against John Robinson for \$12.00 with int. from 15th July 1833. a note against John Will for \$52.97 with int. from 28 Dec 1832. % a note against John Robinson for \$13.80 with int. from 7th Apr 1832 all of which he states were insolvent. an account against Rich^d Epps vs Est for \$132.75 % accounts against John D. Macklin's estate for \$14.72 which was out of date & their representatives refuse to pay. and an account against Rev. Greenway for \$105.00 which he states he paid the estate in his lifetime. for which reasons I have not charged said claims in this account
