will and Testament in manner and form following

and my soul to God who gave it

If I do I give to my Daughter Martha Riot one and furnished that I leave her last
summed to her and her heirs forever

If I do I give to my Daughter Ann Esmonde one Feather bed and furnished to
her and her heirs forever

If I do I give to my Daughter Frances Esmonde one Bed and Furniture to
her and her heirs forever

If I do After the payment of just debts I give the remainder of my estate to Ann
Esmonde, Frances Esmonde and William Esmonde to be equally divided amongst
them to them and their heirs forever

If I do And lastly I constitute and appoint James Clayton my executor to this my last
will and Testament and hereby revoking all ^{other} wills heretofore by me made. In witness
