First I do recommend my body to the Mother of Earth and to be buried in sound Manner and my love to God who gave it=
It 2^d I give to my Daughter Martha Pidot one and furnished that I bought her last Summer to her and her heirs forever=
It 3^d I give to my Daughter Ann Sumnerell one Feather bed and furnished to her and her heirs forever=
It 4th I give to my Daughter Frances Sumnerell one Bed and Furniture to her and her heirs forever=
It 5th After the payment of just debt I give the remainder of my estate to Ann Sumnerell, Frances Sumnerell and William Sumnerell to be equally divided amongst them to them and their heirs forever=
It 6th And lastly I constitute and appoint James Clayton my executor to this my last will and Testament and hereby revoking all ^{other} wills heretofore by me made. In Witness whereof I have set my hand and seal this 16th July 1832
