death or Marriage I give and bequeath all the said property to be equally divided between my five
Children Viz; Martha Ann, Sarah, Mary, Jane Louisa and Caroline; Personal and cash
and my dear beloved wife sole executor of this my last will and Testament hereby revoking
all other and former wills by me at any time heretofore made. In Witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and seal the 29th day of April in the year of our Lord England
