Given Portlet for and during his natural life twenty acres of land including that already cleared the said land to be laid

to my wife Mary the sum of five shillings to be equally divided to my niece Polly Revell the sum of five shillings

and Mary for and during their natural lives all after paying my just debts and I and those after me here but if the said Mary Huggitt should die she is to have the use of said property no longer
