

Oak near a spring in William Newtons line to a Mulberry tree a side line in Newtons line during my wifes life and I desire that my three daughters Susan Bory, Eliza shall remain in the land so lent as their homes during their single lives.

Item 2^d. I give and bequeath unto my son Mrs J Boryant all the balances of my land whatsoever to him and his heirs forever and at the death of my wife Susan Boryant and at the marriage of my three daughters Susan Bory and Eliza I give and bequeath unto Mrs J Boryant my son the remainder of my land to him and his heirs forever.

Item 3^d. I give and bequeath unto my wife Susan Boryant one feather bed and furniture first choice to her and her heirs forever.

Item 4th. I give and bequeath unto my daughter Mary Ann Newton one feather bed and furniture first choice to her and her heirs forever. The item at the request of the Testator was obtained in my presence — John R. Williams

5th Item. I give and bequeath unto my daughter Evey Boryant one feather bed and furniture 3^d choice to her and her heirs forever.

6th Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Eliza Boryant one bed and furniture 2^d choice to her and her heirs forever.

7th Item If my grand daughter Mary Ann Newtons live to the age of twenty one years it is my desire that she shall have one feather bed and furniture fifth choice on pine table and one pine chest otherwise it is to be divided equally between my two daughters aforementioned to them and their heirs forever.

8th Item It is my will and desire the balances of my property not heretofore disposed of may be retained in my wifes possession during her life then I give the same to be equally divided between my daughters Evey and Eliza and my grand daughter Mary Ann Newton if she live to the age of twenty one years otherwise to be equally divided between my two daughters Evey and Eliza to them and their heirs forever.

9th I nominate and appoint my wife Susan Boryant and my son Mrs J Boryant the whole and sole executrix and executor of this my last will and Testament hereby revoking all former will or wills by me made as witness my hand and seal this 4th day of December 1832.
