I Blanton In the name of God amen: I Joseph Blanton of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia do make my last will and Testament as follows: that is to say:
First, I wish all my land and negroes namely, Nally, Lora, George Charles, Mary and Minnie together with all the portable part of my Estate to be sold to the highest bidder and out of the proceeds of such sale I desire that all my just debts be paid. Secondly, I give and bequeath to my negroes, namely, Esther, Lucy, Harriet, Jane, John, Simon, Betsey, Mary, Daniel, Nicholas, and Richard their freedom forever likewise all the future income of the farms and wish them as soon after my decease as practicable to be removed to a free state by my Executors herein after named and their enjoy their freedom forever.
Thirdly, After the payment of my just debts I give and bequeath to my said negroes Lucy Harriet Jane Mary Elizabeth John Simon Bob Nicholas and Richard all my Estate both real and personal in possession and reversion to them and their heirs forever.
