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On the name of God amen I John Anderson of the County of Southampton and State of
Virginia being of sound mind but diseased in body do make this my last will and Testament now being
all that of whatever kind or sale. Item 1 I give unto my beloved sister Julia Anderson (who
has always been kind and dutiful to me) my negro boy Ben during her single life at her
marriage or death he (Ben) is to be returned to my daughter Sarah J Anderson if living if
she be dead to my wife. Item 2 I wish all my perishable estate sold and the money
arising therefrom to be kept on interest for the benefit of my child above named.
Item 3 I then wish all my negroes hired out for the use of beloved wife Sarah Anderson
(formerly Sarah McLemore) and my child One third to my wife and the remaining
two thirds for my child annually but in case the One third should not be sufficient
income for my wife then there shall be an extra appropriation so far as is necessary to.
