

I Harris Holloman of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia being in good
 health and of sound mind and memory do hereby make and constitute this writing to be
 my last will and Testament in manner and form following hereby revoking all former
 wills and Testaments by me made. (1st) Item 1st I desire that all the perishable
 part of my estate be immediately sold after my decease and out of the monies arising
 therefrom all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid - should the perishable
 part of my property prove insufficient for the above purposes then I desire that
 my executor hereafter named may sell enough of my real estate (any part that
 he may deem most proper) and out of the monies arising therefrom pay and satisfy
 all of my debts as shall remain unpaid out of the sales of the perishable part of
 my estate. 2nd After the payment of my just debts and funeral expenses, if there
 should be any of my personal estate left, I give one third of the same balance to Polly
 Hargrave who is at this time living with me on my premises, I give the same to her
 and her heirs forever. I also after the payment of my just debts and funeral
 expenses send unto the said Polly Hargrave one hundred acres of my land with
 the privilege of her taking it just where she prefers so as to include the buildings
 and Orchard. and I also send unto her (the said Polly Hargrave) one third of
 my Negro Slaves, I send her the same land and slaves during her single life so
 long as she shall live in a discreet and lady like conduct - but at her the said Polly
 Hargrave death or marriage or should it appear that she takes up with any man
 to her inducement or defiling or found that a discreet honorable lady like conduct
 and defiled herself then and in any of these cases it is my will and desire
 that she (the said Polly Hargrave) is no longer to enjoy any part of my real
 estate either land or negroes, but for the part I have bequeathed to her to be
 immediately taken out of her possession and at her death or marriage or at the
 time she turns grey (if she should turn grey) any of the above restrictions I
 give all that part of my estate both land and negroes which I have bequeathed to
 her (the said Polly Hargrave) to her two children (viz) to Lucy Ann Hargrave
 and to Edmund Hargrave for the same to be equally divided between them
 I give the same to them and their heirs forever. 3rd It is my will and
 desire that all the remainder of my estate which may be left after paying my just
 debts that I have not before disposed of both real and personal of what-
 soever nature or kind it may consist be equally divided between Lucy Ann
 Hargrave and Edmund Hargrave the daughter and son of Polly Hargrave.
 (and I believe myself to be the father of them which is one thing that induces
 me to give them my estate) I give the same to them and their heirs forever.
 4th It is my will and desire that my friend Benjamin W. Drow be
 guardian for the said two children Lucy Ann Hargrave and Edmund
 Hargrave - 5th I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my friend
 Benjamin W. Drow my whole and sole executor to this my last will and
 Testament, For witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed
 my seal this 10th day of September A.D. 1840 and of the year of our Lord one -
