 came with and together with Samuel H. Holmes and Allen Stephenson his assisting
 entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Eight Thousand dollars
 conditioned as the last directed Certificate is granted there for obtaining a probate
 of the said will in due form.

Stephen In the name of God Amen. I Joel Preford
 of the County of Southampton Do hereby of sound mind and sound memory make and declare this as my
 last will and Testament: I bequeath to my wife the following named negro (Wife) Lewis
 (Commonly called Long Lewis) Parson and Appony, during her natural life time - And at
 her death to my children - And also two of my best Beds with the best furniture for the
 same during her natural life. I also bequeath to my wife that tract of Land with its improve-
 ments which may fall to me whenever a division of Land takes place between my brother
 and myself during her life. Also I give to my wife two of my horses, such as she may
 choose - and my double gig - I also will and direct that she have support for herself
 and family out of my estate for one year - I give to my son James my small gun
 I give to my daughter Mary my Bureau, I desire that my negroes not disposed
 of as above may be disposed of to the best advantage - and the proceeds to be paid
 between my children with the exception of two hundred and fifty dollars to be paid
 to my wife - And One hundred and fifty dollars, which I give to Miss Mary Whiting
 for her services to myself and family. The remainder of my Land together with
 my personal Chattle and other estate not otherwise disposed off I direct and desire
 may be sold for the benefit of my children. I hereby appoint Joshua Preford
 and A. S. H. Burgess Executors of this my last will and Testament. In Testimony of
