 State of Virginia being weak in body but of sound mind and memory thank to Almighty God for
 the same do now make this paper writing as and for my last will and Testament in manner
 and form following to wit: I Give unto my beloved wife Cynthia Adams the
 use of all my lands and plantation for and during her single life upon the special Con-
 dition that she support and raise the three Children I have born by her but should she
 refuse to do so or should she die, I wish her to receive her dower in the same
 I also give her in Consideration of the same during her natural life two feather beds
 and furniture One Cow and Calf and One Sow and pigs and One Chest which Chest she
 brought to my house after we were married. I Give My will and voice is that my
 Executor herein after named do sell at public auction all the the rest of my stock
 and Chattel Goods of every kind except three feather beds and furniture and One
 Cow and Calf which I shall dispose of otherwise and out of the money arising
 from said sale pay all my just debts and expences attending the selling the same
 and the proceeds thereof except just debts after paying my debts as aforesaid shall
 to be equally divided between my wife and the three Children I have born by her
 namely James Lucy and Washington Adams I also give to my three Children as
 above named after the death of my wife all the property I have given and intend to give
 to them and their heirs forever equally divided. I Give My will and voice is
