Nancy Reese
Will

In the name of God Amen. I Nancy Reese of the County of Southampton, being in a low state of health but of sound mind and memory for which I am thankful to Almighty God, but calling to mind the uncertainty of life and the certainty of approaching death do think proper to make my last will and Testament in the following manner Viz.
 I give my soul to God that gave it me in hope of a blessed resurrection thro' Christ my Lord and my body I commend to the earth to be decently buried, and as to my worldly goods I dispose of them as follows.

Item: It is my will and desire that my land should be sold and after my just debts are paid the balance of the proceeds I wish equally divide between my son Thomas L Reese and my two Daughters Edna and Sarah Reese to them and their heirs forever
 Lastly- I do nominate and appoint my son Edwin Reese my executor of this my last Will and Testament working all former Wills by me heretofore made and making this and no other to be my last Will and Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 26 day of May 1842.
