Codicil
 In the name of God. I Sarah Stone of sound & disposing mind and memory, do make this
 Codicil to my last will and testament.
 I give to my daughter in Law Susan B. Stone in addition to the girl Emily sometimes called
 Polly a negro girl named Lucy with the increase of both of them, for her use during her life
 If it shall be necessary to sell any of my negroes to pay my debts. I desire that my Executor
 sell my negro girl Lucy for that purpose.

As my son Joshua is in very poor health, and all my grand children are equally dear to me, it
 is my will & desire that all my other negroes shall be divided between my four grand children
 Sam'l and Sarah alike, and that the negroes Caroline, Emily and Lucy and their future
 increase shall in like manner be divided amongst my said grand children at the death
 of my daughters in Law, to whom I have bequeathed them respectively.

I give to my grand son Wm B. Stone a negro child named Anna child of Chloe over and
 his share of the negroes

If either of my said grand children shall die unmarried & without issue it is my will
 and desire that such child's property given in this will shall be equally divided among
 the survivors of them and so if one or more of them shall die, the survivors or survivor shall
 have the whole.

It is my will and desire that my daughter in Law Susan B. Stone shall have the use
 of her children negroes during her widowhood for the support of her children
 I hereby revoke so much of my said will as is inconsistent with this codicil, & conform it
 in all other respects. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal

At a Court held for the County of Southampton the 17th day of December 1842
 The last will & Testament of Sarah Stone as well as the Codicil thereto was produced
 and was proved by the oaths of Wm S. Goodwyn, Ruthelst B. Barkam & Geo A. H. Newson
 Subscribing witnesses thereto, and Sam'l J. Douglas one of the subscribing witnesses to the
 will being out of the Commonwealth Robert Reilly being sworn depositor de saith that the
 name of the said Sam'l J. Douglas to the said will subscribed is in the hand of the said Sam'l
 J. Douglas whereupon the said will & Codicil are ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of
 John Y. Mason the Executor therein named who made oath together with R. N. Gilliam
 & Nathaniel J. Williams his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the sum of
 four thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs. Certificate is granted him for
 obtaining a probate of the said will & Codicil in due form
