And as no demand has ever been made on him legally for the same, it has been retained by him to this time; and he now exhibits the amount before the Com^{ts} in real court. The Com^{ts} therefore under the circumstances, does not charge the administrator with interest on the intestates proportion of the Estate of her father Jordan Jervis die^d as above stated.
