Will and Testament and desire that all other Wills Testaments &c shall be destroyed
I wish and desire that the disposition of all my property real and personal in
the State of North Carolina and Virginia shall be entrusted to the care of
my worthy and beloved brother Edwin Harrison, and he is hereby requested and
authorized to make such disposition of said property as to him seems most
expedient and just.

I furthermore desire and request that John B Boykin of the State of Mississippi
shall be and he is hereby authorized to act as my lawful Executor to dispose of
all my property real and personal in the State of Mississippi, as the laws of
said State of Mississippi shall direct. made, signed & delivered
this twenty second day of February one thousand eight hundred and forty
three in the presence of
