1st It is my Will and desire that all my just debts and funeral expenses to be paid and discharged.
2nd Item I give unto my niece Elizabeth McCleny my land and plantation where I live and also all my stock of every kind, and beds and furniture of every kind and also go together with all my bonds and money, and all my property of every sort and kind whatever it may consist of to her and her heirs forever. I nominate and name William McCleny of Isle of Wight County my sole and sole executor to this my last will and testament, at herunto I set my hand and affix my seal this
