Jose Crocker
 Will.

In the name of God Amen, I Jose Crocker of the County of
 Southampton and State of Virginia being of sound mind and memory do hereby
 make and ordain this paper writing as for and for my last Will and Testament in
 manner and form following (to wit)

Item. My will and desire is that my Executor herein after named shall sell at
 public Auction (or privately if he shall think proper to do so) as much of my property
 as will be sufficient to pay all my just debts and expenses.

Item. I lend unto my beloved wife Polly Crocker for and during her life, the use
 of all my land with the following exceptions (viz) that my niece Rhoda Mangrum
 shall have during her single life a home in my dwelling house and as much of my
 land of cultivated as would make her a support in meat and bread. I also lend
 to my wife all the rest of my estate of every kind whatever for and during her life
 and if my wife should live to require the use of the money which my land would
 sell for, or any part thereof. I wish my executor to sell it for her benefit while
 Rhoda Mangrum's life right in the same.

Item. If my lands should not be sold during my wife's life time at her death I wish
 the same to be sold, together with all the property which may remain that I have
 bequeathed to her, with all that may be called and known as my estate, all of which
 I give and bequeath to my niece Rhoda Mangrum to her and her heirs forever.

Item. I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my friend Benjamin
 Griffin as my whole and sole executor to this my last will and Testament writing
 all other bequests hereby made. For testimony whereof I have hereunto set my
 hand and seal the 6th day of September 1842.
