Martha Cobb's
Will

I Martha Cobb of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia being in sound and disposed mind do make and ordain this my last will and Testament in manner and form as follows that is to say.

First I give unto my son Leonard Cobb one negro girl Mary which was loaned to me until Ann Lizer Cobb should arrive to the age of sixteen.

Second I also give unto my son Leonard Cobb one half of the balance of my estate after paying all my just debts.

Thirdly I give unto my grandson Winchester Cobb one third of the other half to him and his heirs forever.

Fourthly I give to my granddaughter or son Martha Mills Mary Cobb of William Cobb the remainder two thirds of my estate if any.

Lastly I nominate and appoint my son Leonard Cobb as my Executor to this my last will and Testament. In Witness whereof I set my hand and affix my seal this Twentieth day of October in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty
