Jordan Pope's
Will

In The Name of God Amen. I Jordan Pope of the County of South-
ampton and state of Virginia do hereby make and publish my last Will & Testament
in manner and form following that is to say
Item 1st after the payment of my just debts I leave unto my loving wife Lucy Pope
the whole of my Estate during her natural life and it is my will and desire that
my Executor shall deliver to my loving wife Lucy Pope after the payment of my
just debts the whole of my Estate without requiring her to give refunding bond for the
delivery of my Estate at her death

Item 2nd It is my will and desire that my property such as my furniture in my
house and cooking utensils shall not be sold unless my wife desire it but if she thinks
proper she can let my Executor sell such of my Estate as she may think that she will
not require.

Item 3rd It is my will and desire, that at the death of my loving wife Lucy Pope
that my Estate be equally divided in two parts one half I give unto my loving
wife Lucy Pope to her and her heirs forever.

Item 4th It is my will and desire that the one half of my Estate given to my
wife Lucy Pope in the third item of my will that at the death, or before her death
she may dispose of it as she may think proper.

Item 5th It is my will and desire that the other half of my Estate not here before disposed of I give
to my sister Patience Cox daughter Nancy Cox daughter of John Cox to her heirs forever.

Item 6th It is not my intention that my Executor shall not hold any of my Estate from
my loving wife Lucy Pope after the payment of my just debts but as I have heretofore
mentioned above in this 1st item of my will he will deliver up to her without requiring her
to give a refunding bond the whole of my Estate to hold so long as she lives.

Item 7th & lastly I constitute nominate & appoint John Drury my whole & sole Executor
to this my last will & Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
affix my seal this 12th day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred
and forty three.
