to wit:

Item 1st I lend to my Daughter Elizabeth M. Overneth during her life the following
Negroes that is say Peter Harrison Edmund Ned Blue Julia Manah and all their future
increase and at her death I give all the above named Negroes and their future increase to the
children she now has or may have should they live to lawful age or leave lawful issue
and should all the children of the s^d Elizabeth M. Overneth die leaving no lawful
issue then I in that case I give all the above named Negroes & their future increase to
the children of my Daughter Sally H. Overneth to them and their heirs forever

Item 2^d I Give to my son James Barnes three Dollars:

Item 3^d I give to my son Jacob Barnes Three Dollars:

Item 4th I Give to Daughter Sally H. Overneth Three Dollars:

Item 5 I Give to my Daughter Elizabeth M. Overneth all my Bonds Money and accounts

Item 6 I do hereby Nominate and appoint my son Jacob Barnes Executor to this my
last will and testament in Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal
this 24 day of Dec^r 1842

At a Court held for the County of Southampton on the 18th day of December 1843
The last will and testament of Piusella Barnes dec^d was proved by the oaths of Alexander
Maynor and Henry B. Blow two of the subscribing Witnesses thereof and ordered to be recorded
and on the motion of Jacob Barnes the Executor therein named who made oath and
together with Alexander Maynor & Henry B. Blow his securities entered into and
acknowledged a bond in the penalty of four thousand dollars Conditioned as the law directs
