In The Name of God Amen I John Harris of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia do hereby Make and ordain this paper writing as and for My Last will and Testament in Manner and form following (Wit) I leave unto My beloved wife Mary Harris for and during her single life the following property Namely all of My lands also choice of My household Goods & Cattle of her choice six sheep of her choice one cow & pigs three beds and furniture of her choice one Pig & harness one Cart and wheels for Twelve Months and Three hundred Dollars in Money all the above named property I leave unto her during her single life upon this Special Condition that she raises and schools My two Children but should she marry to take one child part of My Estate both real and personal for and during her Natural life and longer I leave and bequeath all the remainder of My Estate Not bound to my wife to be Equally divided between all My Children Namely
