I Henry Harrison of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia
being in perfect health do make my Last will and Testament in manner and form
following that is to say

Henry
Harrison
Will

1st I wish my Executors whom I shall hereafter appoint immediately after my death
to advertise and sell all the perishable property I may have and out of the proceeds
of such sale pay my just and legal debts and if my perishable estate should be
insufficient to pay the same it is my further desire that they sell one of my Negroes
Jim or Charles or both if required and pay all such debts as I may legally owe

2nd It is my desire and wish and I do hereby give and bequeath unto my
servant Susan her freedom and liberty and for her mentioned services it is my earnest
request that my Executors whom I shall hereafter appoint to release and let her
perfect liberty the said servant Susan and to act as trustees for her in every instance
and I do hereby make the following provision for her maintenance for the said servant
Susan 1st I give and bequeath unto her and her heirs forever the following property
to wit one feather bed and furniture one desk one loom one spinning wheel three chairs
all my kitchen ware and furniture one trundle with all her clothing wearing apparel
and bed clothes one coffee mill and for sea irons one cupboard and two pairs one brass
and one iron one glass provision for herself and horse all the fowls on the plantation
one sow and pigs and one cow and calf of her choice

3rd It is my further wish and request that if my debts are paid without using
my two Negroes Jim and Charles that I leave and bequeath them as follows that my
Executors may dispose of them by hire by one year or otherwise at the option of the said
Susan for the annual support of my old Negro woman Susan their Mother during her
life and at her death I do hereby give them their freedom provided she be supported
without the sale of them being required and if she should remove to any place
my request that my Executors permit the said Jim and Charles to go with her and
enjoy their freedom

4th I give and bequeath unto my servant Susan the land and improvements
