

on which I live containing one hundred and sixty one acres being the land given me by my Father by his will unto her and at her death to my two servants and their children Martha Mason to be equally divided between the said Martha & Mason and if any thing should occur and the laws of this state will not permit them to remain so that they are compelled to remove to a free state it is my wish that my executors or Commissioners appointed by the Court sell the land and divide the money equally between my 2 servants Susan Martha and Mason unto them and their heirs forever.

5th I do hereby give and bequeath to my servant Anthony his liberty and freedom and particularly request my executors that they set him at perfect liberty immediately after my decease: and I do further give and bequeath unto my said servant Anthony the tract of land and improvements of all kinds which I purchased of Joseph St. Cormall called Browns land containing by estimation and survey two hundred and fifty five acres unto him the 2^d Anthony and his heirs forever and if he should die without lawful heirs I wish and desire and do hereby bequeath the land to be equally divided between my servants John Martha and Mason unto them and their heirs and if the laws of the state or any thing else should occur so as to prevent the said Anthony from remaining in this state in that case my wish and desire is that my executors or Com^{rs} appointed by the Court sell the land and pay the proceeds over to the 2^d servant Anthony if he be alive if not to his heirs if no heirs to the 2^d John Martha and Mason or to their heirs &c

6th I give and bequeath unto my 2^d servant Anthony one bay mare one colt of my own one cow & calf one sow and pigs one feather bed and furniture and one cart and wheels and one years provisions unto him and his heirs forever

7th I do hereby give and bequeath unto my servant Mason and her children Tom Lucy Lucy Clara Sally and Carter and all her future increase from this time their entire freedom and liberty to each and every one of them and my positive wish is that my executors set them at perfect liberty immediately at my decease and I do by this will give and bequeath unto the 2^d Mason one feather bed & furniture her years provision for herself and children 1 sow and pigs and one Cow and calf unto her and her heirs forever

8th I do hereby give and bequeath unto my servant Martha and her children Henry Betty and Hannah their liberty and freedom entire also to her future increase and it is my warmest wish and desire that my executors set them at perfect liberty at my decease and I do further by this will give and bequeath unto the 2^d Martha one years provision for herself and her children also one feather bed & furniture one Cow & calf and one sow and pigs unto her and her heirs forever

9th I do by this Will give and bequeath unto my servant John his entire liberty and freedom and it is my desire and wish that my executors immediately at my decease set him at perfect liberty: and I also give and hereby bequeath unto him the said John the following property to wit - one Musc one feather bed and furniture one Cow & calf and one sow & pigs unto him and her heirs forever

10th and if there should be any property that I have not disposed of in my will above: I wish it to be ^{equally} divided between all my legates above mentioned particularly my
