5^o I do hereby give and bequeath to my servant Anthony his liberty and freedom
and particularly request my Executors that they set him at perfect liberty
immediately after my decease; and I do further give and bequeath unto my said
servant Anthony the tract of land and improvements of all kinds which I
purchased of Joseph St. Oormal called Brown's land Containing by Estimation
and Survey Two hundred and Fifty five acres unto him the said Anthony and
his heirs forever and if he should die without lawful heirs at wished and desire and
do hereby bequeath the land to be equally divided between my servants John
Martha and Mason unto them and their heirs and if the laws of the state or any
thing else shoud occur so as to prevent the said Anthony from remaining in this
state in that case my wish and desire is that my Execr or Comr appointed by
the Court sell the land and pay the proceeds over to the said servant Anthony of herbe
also if Not to his heirs if no heirs to the said John Martha and Mason or to their
heirs &c

6^o I Give and bequeath unto my said servant Anthony one bay Mare one colt of
oxen one Cow & Calf one sow and pigs one feather bed and furniture and one cart and
wheels and one years provision unto him and his heirs forever

7^o I do hereby give and bequeath unto my servant Mason and her children
Tom Seely Lucy Clara Lucy and Carter and all her future increase from this
time their complete freedom and liberty to leave and returne one of them and my
positive wish is that my Execr set them at perfect liberty immediately at my
decease and I do by this will give and bequeath unto the said Mason one feather
bed & furniture her years provision for herself and children 1 sow and pigs and one
Cow and Calf unto her and her heirs forever

8^o I do hereby give and bequeath unto my servant Martha and her children Henry
Patsy and Hannah their liberty and freedom ent're also to her future increase and
it is my earnest wish and desire that my Execr set them at perfect liberty at my
decease and I do further by this will give and bequeath unto the said Martha one
years provision for herself and her children also one feather bed & furniture one Cow & Calf
and one sow & pigs unto her and her heirs forever

9^o I do by this Will give and bequeath unto my servant John his entire
liberty and freedom and it is my desire and wish that my Execr immediately at my
decease set him at perfect liberty; and I also give and hereby bequeath unto him the
said John the following property to wit one Mule one feather bed and furniture one Cow & Calf
and one sow & pigs unto him and his heirs forever

10^o and if there shoud be any property that I have Not disposed of in my will
above I wish it to be ^{equally} divided between all my legatees above mentioned particularly by my
