 I also give to each of my daughters on her Marriage one feather bed and and furniture to be
 and valued Two ward and the sum of Five Thousand Dollars to be delivered and paid as soon after
 the Marriage as practicable My Daughter Elizabeth's portion to be paid as soon after
 as practicable all allotments to be made and child's share is to be Reserved and the
 undivided shares of the other children for the use of my wife and at her death of any
 share so to be Reserved for her to be equally divided between my three daughters
 Joshua Cornelius & and Rosa & Claude".

It is my wish that the several divisions sole be made be effected by the same
 Commissioners to be appointed by the County Council of Southampton as far as practicable.
 Item I Give to my son Joseph M. Claude wher he attains the age of Seventy one in
 my plantation consisting of the lands bought of John and Joseph Barker and the
 Williford tract and the sum of land I purchased belonging to the Estate of George
 Phipps etc and the plantation devised to me by Capt Holt now on the possession of the
 Nancy Holt for her life which will come into his possession at her death I also Give
 him all the stock of every kind which may be on the said plantation when my son
 attains full age and all the crops of every kind which may be made on the said plantation
 in the year of his coming of age I also Give to my said son an equal share forth full
 my Negro slaves except those specially bequeathed to my Mother as one to share
 before directed at that time also the sum of Five hundred Dollars then to be paid him
 by him furniture and if I shall not in my lifetime take down house and have
 finished for him the dwelling house in whicht John Barker did live it my will and
 desire that my Executor and Executrix have it done for him at the expence of my wife
 the house to be moved to a place on said plantation wher I have already made
 settlement I also give to my said son one bed and furniture and his choice of all my
 horses.

Item I Give to my two sons Joshua and Cornelius at the death of my wife if she
 my widow otherwise at her Marriage all the rest of my lands of which I may be
 possessed except the tract of land I purchased of John D. Turner called the said
 plantation to be equally divided between them and if my wife shall live to see her
 attain lawful age I authorize her to places either or both of them in possession of any part
 the same less than one half and in the division to be made at her death such parts
 to be allotted at its value to the one in possession therof. In the event of her surviving
 either of my said sons the Executive or Executrix is authorized to give to such son a part
 the stock of Cattle sheep &c as she or he may think proper not exceeding a child
 portion of the whole than in proportion as my said sons Joshua & Cornelius respectively
 the age of twenty one years I Give to each of them a child's share of the undivided Negro
 excluding those children who may have Received their shares and leaving their share
 shares as above directed"

Item. It is my will and desire that my river plantation shall be kept up by my
 Executive and Executrix as I have directed the balance of my farms until the death of
 my wife upon the happening of either event it is my will and desire that
 the said land shall be sold and the proceeds be divided between my living children and
 the descendants of any that may be dead taking principles
 Item At the death of Mrs Nancy Holt widow of Capt Holt it is my will
