 I also give to each of my daughters on her Marriage one feather bed and one chamber
 and colour Towels and the sum of Two Thousand Dollars to be advanced and paid as soon after
 the Marriage as practicable my Daughter Elizabeth B. portion to her part as soon after
 as practicable the all allotments to be made one child's share is to be reserved for the
 undivided shares of the other children for the use of my wife and at her death I give the
 share so to be reserved for her to be equally divided between my three youngest children
 Joshua Cornelius E and Rosal E. Child.

It is my wish that the several divisions to be made be effected by the same
 Commissioners to be appointed by the County Court of Southampton as far as practicable.
 I give to my son Joseph M. Child when he attains the age of Twenty one years
 my plantation consisting of the lands bought of John and Joseph Barkham and the
 Willford tract and the piece of land I purchased belonging to the Estate of Thomas
 Phipps dec^d and the plantation devised to me by Sefel Holt then in the possession of
 Nancy Holt for her life which will come into his possession at her death I also give
 him all the stock of every kind which may be on the said plantation when my son
 attains full age and all the crops of every kind which may be made on the said plantation
 in the year of his coming of age I also give to my said son an equal child's part for
 my Negro slaves except those specially designated Counting his Mother as one to share as
 before directed at that time also the sum of Five hundred Dollars then to be paid toward
 buying him furniture and if I shall not in my lifetime take down more and have
 finished for him the dwelling houses in which John Barkham dec^d lived it will not
 answer that my Executor and Executor have it done for him at the expense of my said
 the house to be moved to a place on said plantation where I have already made
 settlement I also give to my said son one bed and furniture and his choice of all my
 horses.

I give to my two sons Joshua and Cornelius at the death of my wife if she survive
 my widow otherwise at her Marriage all the rest of my lands of which I may be
 possessed except the tract of land I purchased of John D. Turner called the new
 plantation to be equally divided between them and if my wife shall live to her full
 attain lawful age I authorize her to place either or both of them in possession of any part
 the same less than one half and in the division to be made at her death such part
 to be allotted at its value to the one in possession thereof. In the event of her so dying
 either of my said sons the Executor or Executor is authorized to give to such son a portion
 the stock of cattle sheep &c as she or he may think proper not exceeding a child's
 portion of the whole then in possession as my said sons Joshua & Cornelius respectively
 the age of twenty one years I give to each of them a child's share of the undivided
 including those children who may have received their shares and counting their Mother as
 share as above directed.

I give to my will and desire that my river plantation shall be kept up by my
 Executor and Executor as I have directed the balance of my fortune until the death of
 my wife upon the happening of either event It is my will and desire that
 the said land shall be sold and the proceeds be divided between my living children and
 the descendants of any that may be dead taking preference
 I give to the death of Mrs Nancy Holt widow of Sefel Holt dec^d It is my will
