

and desire that the Negroes in her possession to which I am then entitled by the said
 Sister Will shall fall into my Estate and if any of my children shall have received his
 or her share of my Negro slaves that such child or children shall then draw his or her
 share of them in the same manner as if they had been in possession of my Estate
 when such divisions may have taken place and if the said Negroes cannot be
 divided in kind so as for their respective shares to be allotted to them of my children
 who may have received their shares then I direct that their respective shares of them
 shall be valued and such valuations to be paid to each so situated out of my
 Monied Estate"

Item It is my will and desire that all the Money which may remain of my
 Estate after payment of debts and the pecuniary legacies and other charges made on it
 in this will with the accruing interest and surplus profits of my Estate including the
 Money to which I am entitled at the death of Mrs Nancy North and the legacy
 left by Sister North to Joshua Glendon of Tompsee which I purchased of him in his life
 time he kept at interest the interest to be collected annually and placed at interest
 during her life or widowhood of my wife and at her death or marriage I give the
 same to be equally divided between all my children then living and the descendants of
 any that may be dead leaving posterity;

Item If my wife Renounce this will or marry again I hereby annul and revoke all
 bequests herein in her favour and it is my will on her second Marriage or Renunciation
 that her power as Executrix shall be Revoked, but it is my will and desire in either
 event that the share of Negroes which she would have been entitled to for life shall
 be set apart to my youngest children as an equivalent for the legacies given their
 Brother and sisters."

Item I desire that the piece or tract of land which I purchased of Thomas D
 Ridgely and wife if unalienated at my death shall be sold by my Executor or Executor and the
 proceeds form a part of my Monied Estate and pass as that portion of my Estate is directed
 to be divided amongst my children

✓ Item If contrary to my Expectations my wife shall renounce this provision I have
 herein made with an anxious desire for her comfort and the interest of our children I
 give and desire to my three sons all my lands as herein before directed subject to her
 claim of dower to be proposed by them from the date of her renunciation I also give and
 bequeath in that event all my Negroes except those specially bequeathed subject to her
 claim of dower to be then divided into eight parcels of equal value one of which I give to
 Joseph M. one to Elizabeth B. one to Martha one to Adeline and the other four bequeath
 to my three younger children to be equally divided and after the payment of Two
 Thousand Dollars to each of my three eldest daughters and Five hundred to Joseph I
 bequeath all my Monies and other Estates to be equally divided amongst all my children

Item If one or more of my children shall die without issue and under age I give all
 the property herein given to such child or children to the survivors and so if all die but one
 then I give all my Estate to that one If on the death of one If on the death of one of
 my children there be living a child or children of one previously dying such child or children
 to take the share which the Father or Mother would take by this clause if then alive"

Item It is my will and desire that my Executor and Executor shall sell any of my
 property as they may think best for the interest of my Estate and the proceeds to be
