Hancock Burwell & Lucy Anne Hancock my Negro man Slave one brother his & furniture &
divided equally between them my Daughter Hancock having had the same in preffed

4th I Give unto my Daughters Rebecca Briggs and my Daughter Martha Williams all my
Lands until one or the other should Marry if either of them should Marry then my Lands
is to be sold and the money arising therefrom after paying my Debts to be divided into three
equal parts one third part I Give to my Daughter Rebecca Briggs one third part to Martha
Williams & the Remaining third part to my Daughter Eliza G. Hancock four children as
Namely all my other property of any kind whatsoever to be sold & the proceeds thereof to be
divided into three equal parts one third part I Give unto my Daughter Rebecca Briggs
