1st I Give unto my Daughter Martha Williams my Negro woman Ann my boy named Sam my Land one Brother bed & furniture to her & her heirs
2^d I Give unto my Daughter Rebecca Briggs one Brother bed & furniture my Negro woman Franky to her & her heirs
3^d I Give unto my Daughter Eliza C. Hancock children namely Martha Virginia William Henry James Swarth & Lucy Ann Hancock my Negro man Sam one Brother bed & furniture to be divided equally between them my Daughter Hancock having had the same in possession
4th I Give unto my Daughters Rebecca Briggs and my Daughter Martha Williams all my Land Lanes until one or the other should. Many If either of them should. Many then my Land is to be sold and the money arising therefrom after paying my Debts to be divided into three equal parts one third part I Give to my Daughter Rebecca Briggs one third part to Martha Williams & the remaining third part to my Daughter Eliza C. Hancock four children as above named all my other property of any kind whatsoever to be sold & the proceeds thereof to be divided into three equal parts one third part I Give unto my Daughter Rebecca Briggs
