Charlotte older one hundred Dollars but should all or either of my heirs at before I die
and one hundred dollars given to each of them I give to my friend John J. Massey to have
and his heirs forever.

And All the rest of my Estate of every kind I give to my friend John J. Massey to have
and his heirs forever.

Lastly I Nominate the said John J. Massey my sole Executor of this my last will and
Testament. In Witness whereof I have set my hand and affixed my seal this 29
day of September one thousand eight hundred and forty one
