A gerrably To an order of the County Court of Southampton dated May last 1864 I have this day  
 settled Jacob Barnes' Executor's accounts and George Whitfield's Estate and find a balance due to him  
 of one hundred and thirty six dollars \$83/00 as above stated including interest to this 13 day of June  
 1864 which said sum the said Jacob Barnes exec has this day paid over to Michael Thompson  
 Whitfield and Jonathan S. Griffon execs of George Whitfield in my presence and taken their  
 Receipts for the same. Perfectly submitted to the County Court under my hand this 13 day  
 June 1864.

At a Court held for the County of Southampton on the 17 day of June 1864.  
 This account of Jacob Barnes administration on the Estate of George Whitfield, exec was passed  
 and ordered to his exec. Tamm for Execution and at a court held for the County a few days  
 (15 day) of July 1864. The said account having been so Tamm and the Execution being filed  
 confirmed and ordered to the Recordals.

I am the witness of God witness of Nancy Estate of the County of Southampton and do  
 of my self do make and ordain this to be my last will and Testament in manner and form  
 following to wit:

In witness I give to my friend John G. Mason my Negro slaves Sarah & Anna and to  
 four children with their future increase on his saying to my friend Sally Sharp wife of John  
 Sharp one hundred Dollars to my friend Sarah Slaves and hundred dollars and to my friend  
 Charlotte Slaves one hundred Dollars but should all or either of my slaves die before he  
 dies one hundred dollars given to each of them I give to my friend John G. Mason to him  
 and his heirs forever.

Item All the rest of my estate of every kind I give to my friend John G. Mason to be  
 and his heirs forever.

I do by my Nominate this said John G. Mason my sole Director of this my last will and  
 Testaments for witness whereof I have set my hand and affixed my seal the 29  
 day of September one thousand eight hundred and forty one  
 sign'd sealed and acknowledged
