in the manner and form following Viz

1. I Give unto my sister Dorothy Downy the tract of land whereon I now live with all the appurtenances belonging therunto also Colby and Stephens to her and to her heirs.
2. To my Niece Abner Westland I Give Robinson and Siny to her and to her heirs forever
3. To my Niece Melisa J. Nicholson I Give Peter downward and Mary Hunt to her and to her heirs forever
4. To my Niece Catharine W. Cobb I Give John and Sylvia to her and to her heirs forever
5. To my Niece Ann M. White I Give Oliver to her and to her heirs forever
6. To my Niece Sarah A Cobb I Give Volving and Nancy to her and to her heirs forever
7. To my Niece Margaret J. Cobb I Give Friedrich and Judy to her and to her heirs forever

8. It is my will and desire that the Remaining part of my Estate Not herebefore disposed of shall be sold and after my Debt debts and funeral expenses are Paid the balance of the Money to be Equally divided amongst the above Named legates

9. I do hereby constitute and appoint my friend Benjamin Downy Executor to this my last will and Testament hereby Revoking all other and former Wills by me heretofore made In Testimony Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 15 day of October 1844
